**MEETING HELD LIBRARY**

**CALL TO ORDER: 7:03 PM**

**ROLL CALL: Present:** Beers, Decker, Morris, McCoy, and Steele. Fox and Peabody absent.

**TREASURER'S REPORT:** Wacha report the line item added for the recent ARPA-Federal Covid funds we received. Entries will read ARPA1 for expense. Motion made by Beers and seconded Steele to accept Treasurer's Report. Motion passed unanimously.

**DPW:** Decker read review of recent projects containing snow removal, Eaton County Health Department received a complaint pertaining to the community building and will be out to inspect. Beers reported the Kitchen inspection was certified. Furnace in main office building has quit and must be repaired. A quote was presented to the committee. Consumers Energy will submit the information pertaining to the Dollar General upon completion of evaluation recently. Currently share the storage of salt with Mulliken as there is a leak in their facility.
