REGULAR MEETING OF THE VILLAGE COUNCIL 2022 - 2023

MEETING HELD LIBRARY

CALL TO ORDER: 7:03 PM

ROLL CALL: Present: Beers, Decker, Fox, Morris, Peabody and Steele. McCoy absent.

TREASURER'S REPORT: Review received the second disbursement of ARPA funds. Final payment has been made for street repairs. All transfers have been conducted. Motion made by Beers and seconded Steele to accept Treasurer's Report. Motion passed unanimously.

APPROVAL OF BILLS: Review of bills Fox asked for further information pertaining to the Precision Grade bill of \$18,797.50 Decker reviewed and established all future bids must be in written form detailing all services to be done. Motion made by Peabody and seconded by Beers to accept and pay the bills. Motion passed unanimously.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES: Motion was made by Fox to approve the minutes for previous meeting and seconded by Steele. Motion passed unanimously.

EATON COUNTY SHERIFF REPORT: Decker read the report. 15 calls to report.

DPW: Decker reviewed the fence in park kids kicked down he is waiting on a bid to install approximately 155 feet of fencing. The camera has been fixed. Discussion of installing more units of security cameras throughout the village.

WATER & SEWER: none given. Decker did note that future correspondence pertaining to the Village will be type on bills. Discussion by Wacha with increase of postage consider distributing the quarterly water and sewer bills electronically to those that have the access.

OLD BUSINESS: Dollar General review of relocation of power lines and poles. Estimate currently is \$57,000 Further discussion and clarification to continue.

NEW BUSINESS: Decker led the discussion to review the letter and pictures distributed regarding 422 First Street. The next steps will be Eaton County circuit court. Motion made by Fox and seconded by Steel to pursue further legal action in the matter to clean up and establish this property to code. Tabled resolution rules of procedure for August meeting. Reminder of Election year and confirm those that need to be placed on the ballot for November vote.
