REGULAR MEETING OF THE VILLAGE COUNCIL 2022 - 2023

MEETING HELD LIBRARY

CALL TO ORDER: 7:04 PM

ROLL CALL: Present: Beers, Decker, McCoy, Fox, Morris, Peabody and Steele.

TREASURER'S REPORT: Wacha gave a brief review of the accounts and discussed state and federal tax updates. Informed the council that the budget reflects the quarterly equipment/labor transfers. Motion made by Steele and seconded Beers to accept Treasurer's Report. Motion passed unanimously.

APPROVAL OF BILLS: Clerk read to the council the 4 bills present to pay, and email of bills to pay report to follow. Motion made by Peabody and seconded by Steele to accept and pay the bills. Motion passed unanimously.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES: Review of minutes with no concerns. Motion was made by Steele and seconded by Peabody to approve the March minutes. Motion passed unanimously.

EATON COUNTY SHERIFF REPORT: 18 calls to report.

DPW: DPW Manager report did a simple review of current activities around the village. Established the trash account with Granger. The playground at the Parks needs attention and funding. Estimate made water tower repairs, cleaning, painting \$155,000. Eta on water tower is late summer early fall. Review of furnace estimates presented to the council. After a lengthy review of each estimate and the services, the council made a motion by Morris and seconded by Steele to hire Candor Mechanical LLC at an estimate cost of \$3600.

WATER & SEWER: none given.

OLD BUSINESS: Continued the discussion of Fishbeck and grant applications to service the pump station, force main, and dig a new well. Motion made by Beers and seconded by Steele to host a public meeting; motion carried unanimously. It will be scheduled for April 25, 2023, at 7:00 pm Community Building. A postcard mailing will be done to all residents currently active on the water and sewer billing. They will be discussion at the public meeting to raise the water and sewer rates approximately \$4.50.

NEW BUSINESS: Clerk Snedegar presented to the council information for the Village of Sunfield website, and the information that would be included. The council shared ideas with important information for the residents of Sunfield. Motion made by Morris and seconded by Beers to design and build a website for the Village of Sunfield. Motion passed unanimously.

CORRESPONDENCE: none read

ADJOURNMENT: Motion made by Beers and seconded by Peabody to adjourn. Motion carried unanimously. Meeting adjourned at 8:24 PM.
