**REGULAR MEETING OF THE VILLAGE COUNCIL 2023-2024**

**PUBLIC HEARING – COMMUNITY BUILDING**

**CALL TO ORDER: 6:53 PM**

**ROLL CALL: Present Beers Decker Fox Morris, Peabody and Steel. McCoy Absent**
